## **Maine Hoops Tournament Rules**

Game Rules are all NFHS (regular) basketball rules with some exceptions as follows.

- 1. Game Times Grades 4-6 play 14 minute halves, 7-up 16 minute halves. Clock will run in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half anytime the lead is over 20 points with 8 minutes left in the half. If we are ahead of schedule, officials have the leeway to stop clock on foul shots.
- 2. Pressing there is no Full Court pressing in the 2nd Half of games when a team is up by more than 20 points.
- 3. Free throws (1-1) will be shot on the 10<sup>th</sup> foul of the half, 2 shots on the 12<sup>th</sup> foul. Shooting Fouls are always shot.
- 4. Time Outs have 3 Timeouts per game. You have 2 full timeouts and one 30 second timeout.
- 5. 3 minute warm up before games and 2 minute halftimes.
- 6. Overtime All overtimes are 2 minutes stop time in length, with one timeout added. After one overtime, we go to Sudden Win, unless a championship or playoff game event.
- 7. Coaches/Players receiving 2 Technical fouls will be ejected and cannot play in next game.

## Other Rules

- 1. In the 4th grade division, the Foul Shooter must start behind the line, but may go over the line after the release of the foul shot.
- 2. Players can only participate on one team in a grade division. A player can participate on different teams as long as they are in different Grades.
- 3. Pool Play TieBreakers First tie breaker is Head to Head. 2nd Tie Breaker is +/- scoring differential up to 15 points.
- 4. Basketball Size 28.5 for Girls and Boys grades 4-6.
